As part of our Prep Science unit on growth, we will be visiting Chesterfield Farm on Thursday 22nd June 2017. The children will be involved in hands on experiences of farm life. Some activities may include, feeding animals, milking a cow, a tractor- drawn wagon ride and a visit to the education centre where children will talk with one of the farmers about Australian farming and produce.

The details are as follows:

Time: 9.15-2.45pm

Cost: Covered by the Excursion Levy



On the day, children will need to bring lunch and snack, in plastic bags (no lunch boxes please), in a small backpack. We recommend that children wear suitable footwear such as gumboots and a warm jacket in case of cold/wet weather.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school promptly by 9:00am, as the bus will depart at 9:15am.

We will require two parent helpers with a current working with children check to assist with the excursion (Please see us if you are interested in helping.) These parent helpers will be required to come on the bus and assist the children at the farm, and they will gain free entry to the farm. (No toddlers on the bus please.)

All other parents who wish to join us are welcome to meet us at Chesterfield Farm, however please be advised that if you do attend, the admission fee for adults is \$13.
