## 2018 Grade 5/6 Camp Narmbool

As part of our curriculum focus the 5/6 students will be attending the *Narmbool Environmental Discovery Camp* in conjunction with an excursion to Sovereign Hill. This excursion will include a lesson from the education offices at Sovereign Hill and the opportunity to explore the gold mines and experience panning for gold.

Dates of Camp: **Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> of June to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> of June.**

The program, over the four days, has been prepared for us by the Narmbool staff based on our inquiry unit for term 2 'Act Local, Think Global' which focuses primarily on Sustainability. Included in this camp is 'Those Outstanding Owls' and a visit from the Ballarat Observatory. Narmbool allows students to explore the magnificent bushland and pastures with a focus on environmental science, Australian history and the arts. Students will develop a greater awareness and understanding of the importance of sustainability and Australian history and cultures.

Attached is a medical form, which should be returned to school with the deposit on or before Tuesday the 17<sup>th</sup> of April.

The total cost for this camp is \$432.00. The deposit of \$100 is required by Tuesday the 17<sup>th</sup> of April. The deposit must be paid by the due date so we can finalise staffing and booking arrangements with three further payments to follow.

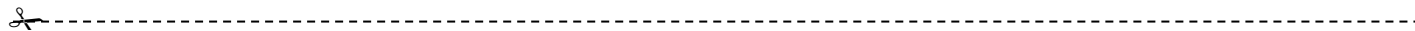

As part of our curriculum focus the 5/6 students will be attending the *Narmbool Environmental Discovery Camp* in conjunction with an excursion to Sovereign Hill. This excursion will include a lesson from the education offices at Sovereign Hill and the opportunity to experience panning for gold and explore the gold mines.

Sandra Douglas and Lindsay Hannah will be the staff members attending this camp. **In case of an emergency during the 12<sup>th</sup>- 15<sup>th</sup> of June parents/guardians should contact Lindsay Hannah on 0405944199.** Any other general inquiries during this time should be directed to the school office staff as they will have a copy of all relevant and important information. Alternatively, all general information is included below.

Departure: We will be departing from school at 8am sharp. **Students will be expected to be at school at 7:45am on Tuesday the 12<sup>th</sup> of June** in order to load bags onto the bus.

Return: We will be departing Narmbool at approximately 1pm on the 17<sup>th</sup> of June. This means **we are likely to return by 3pm on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June.** Upon return, students will be required to notify Sharon Reiss-Stone or Lindsay Hannah in order to be dismissed.

Travel Arrangements: On The 12<sup>th</sup> of June, a seat belted bus will drive students and staff to Sovereign Hill, we will then be dropped off at Narmbool lodge on the 12<sup>th</sup> of June. We will then be transported back to school by a seat belted bus on the 15<sup>th</sup> of June.

Distance from expert medical care: During our stay at Narmbool, we will be 35 minutes (35km) from the nearest hospital (Ballarat). Narmbool requires one adult attending the camp to have access to a private vehicle, to assist in the unlikely case of a student needing to seek medical care. Please ensure all medical information is accurately completed on the attached form.

Accommodation: Students will be sharing a cabin with a small group of peers. Narmbool lodge is located on **Horsehill North Road, Elaine VIC 3334**
