MWHPS has just developed a technology partnership with Datacom, Google and Hewlett-Packard. This partnership will see MWHPS become a world-class IT Beacon School with cutting edge practices that will assist students on the journey to becoming future leaders in an ever changing world. 21st Century skills such as collaboration, communication, personal/social skills and critical and creative thinking skills will be enhanced in a curriculum brought to life through innovative practices.

#### What this means for MWHPS:

- Collaborating with the best in the industry to improve our practices and provide opportunities for our students to be active global citizens
- A STEAM Program where rigorous academic concepts are coupled with real world lessons as students apply Science, Technology, Engineering, The Arts and Mathematics in contexts that make connections between school and real-life learning
- Teachers will participate in a range of professional learning opportunities, which will see them work with other educators around
- Trial new industry ideas and provide feedback for change
- Utilise Google G Suite for Education to engage, collaborate and provide instant feedback to improve student learning

# **Curriculum Update**

Last week we had another session of Piece Together Prep. The art session saw the kinder children make shapes and a fish with clay. They rolled the clay to make sausages and coiled it around like a snail, developing their fine motor skills.







Piece Together Prep is a program that assists children and families to become familiar with a

primary school environment. It is also an opportunity for families to mingle and get to know others in their local community. The program develops school readiness skills such as cooperation, listening, independence, literacy and numeracy skills. It ensures children and families make a positive start to school, feeling confident and comfortable. Children visit a variety of different classrooms working with a number of different teachers just as our students do. Children develop social and emotional skills as part of Piece Together Prep by interacting with one another and through group work. Thank you to Mrs. Furlong for running the wonderful session.


