The Mathematics Challenge for Young Australians (MCYA) is a staged program designed to help teachers motivate, stimulate, encourage and develop mathematically interested students in Years 3 to 10 to bring forth the talent and potential within. The MCYA is an ideal program for extension studies and for students who would benefit from greater challenge.

The first two stages of the MCYA provide problems and course work to extend and develop students in mathematical problem solving, while teachers receive detailed solutions and support materials.

Certificates are presented at the end of the challenge and students are able to achieve: H=High Distinction, D=Distinction, C=Credit, Pr=Proficiency, Pa=Participation



Curriculum Update

The preps have been working hard mathematically! They have been using hands on equipment to model and represent numbers.









Using blocks, counters and unifix students construct models to develop their understanding of numbers. Teachers plan maths sessions using our REACH instructional framework and develop learning intentions and success criteria around the Victorian Curriculum. Teachers in P - 2 are using "ELF" which is Everyone's Learning Focus so students know what the teaching focus is for the lesson. The Raising Children website has many great ideas to build numeracy in children.
