


LATE ARRIVALS - EVERY MINUTE COUNTS





Assistant Principal's Report

Curriculum Update

On Monday staff participated in a professional learning session focused on 6 + 1 Traits of writing. Mrs Despotellis, Mrs Douglas, Miss Bolton and Miss Sullivan planned and ran the day providing staff with valuable knowledge around the traits of writing. The Six Traits of writing are Voice, Ideas, Conventions, Organization, Word Choice, Sentence Fluency + Presentation. It gives teachers and students a common language around writing skills. Following on from the previous work we have done on the traits we focused on sentence fluency and word choice.

Sentence fluency is the rhythm and flow of a sentence. It is what we listen for when reading, good writing allows the reader to bring expression to the text. As you read a text, sentences vary in length, beginning, structure and style. Word choice is the vocabulary that writers use to not only convey meaning but brings the piece to life. Students learn to use new, vivid and dynamic words within their writing and become aware of the power of vocabulary.

The teachers participate in mini lessons and hands on activities throughout the professional learning session.



Prep transition was last Friday and we had another wonderful session! Mrs Despotellis, Mrs Morris and Helen took our 2019 prep students through a maths activity. The students did some counting and number recognition. Once again as you can see from the photos everyone did an awesome job and settled really well.






