This year the Specialist Team will be using an app/website called Seesaw. It is a convenient and handy tool where parents and families can keep up to date and connect with what students are learning in Art, Music, PE and Japanese.

We will be posting pictures and videos to individuals, groups and whole classes and you will have access to view these.

The main purpose of Seesaw is an informal sharing of class / individual work and activities and the creation of a digital portfolio. Because Seesaw allows us to post videos of your child in action, this format will allow us to provide you with a much better representation of their skills and achievements than the previous paper portfolio format.

You will receive a personalised QR code and instructions on how to access your child's account. For privacy and protection, it is essential to know that:

- Families can only see work posted in their own child's journal / account
- Teachers control what is shared and with whom
- Families do not see the work of anyone else in their class
- Families can connect with siblings.
