Dear Parents,

As part of our Health and Safety unit this term, the Prep students will be attending the Casey Safety Village. We will be expanding on our knowledge of fire safety in a simulated home environment, and we will be learning all about passenger, pedestrian and bike safety when near our roads. Students will even be able to ride a bike in the village and practice what we have learnt. Bikes and helmets will be provided by the venue (training wheels are available if needed).

The details are as follows:

- Date:** Friday 2nd August 2019
- Venue:** Casey Safety Village - Site 06, 65 Berwick Cranbourne Road Cranbourne East 3977
- Time:** 9:00am – 2:00pm
- Cost:** Covered by the Excursion Levy

On the day, children will need to bring a substantial snack, in plastic bags (no lunch boxes please), in a small backpack, as well as a water bottle. (Lunch will be eaten when we arrive back at school so needs to be sent as usual.)

Children must be in full school uniform and wear suitable footwear that is fully enclosed, such as runners. Girls are also advised to wear shorts/leggings on the day rather than skirts/dresses.

Please ensure that your child arrives at school promptly by 8:45am, as the bus will depart at 9:00am.

We will require parent helpers with a current working with children check to assist with the excursion (Please see us if you are interested in helping.) These parent helpers will be required to come on the bus and assist the children at Casey Safety Village. However, the venue has requested that no siblings be brought along.
