Principal's Report

PMSS (Primary Mathematics and Science specialist Initiative) Training

This week I had the pleasure of attending the PMSS (Maths focus) professional learning alongside Mrs Datson and Mrs Despotellis. Carolyn and Georgia have extended their learning over the past couple of days. On Monday, Principals were asked to attend with the focus on ways we can create the conditions necessary for professional discernment to emerge, continue to develop and flourish. I also had the opportunity to participate in a math activity run by Dr James Russo. Stepping back into the student role enabled me to appreciate the difficulties and pressures that students may feel when faced with a challenging problem! The last session provided an opportunity to hear from two Principals who have completed their PMSS journey. They reflected on the triumphs and challenges. The first year of this two year project was for specialist teachers to strengthen their content, curriculum and assessment practices. The next step is for our leaders to begin to influence other teachers through peer mentoring and peer coaching.

Thank you to everyone who has returned forms and purchased clothing for our school production next Thursday 29th. There is an expectation that all students attend. The reasons for this are

- To provide opportunities for students who have strengths in this field to excel
- To develop Performing Arts skills. The Performing Arts play a hugely significant role in helping children to develop their creative skills. They help to develop creative minds and fostering personalities and imaginations.
- Opportunity to grow: Challenging yourself can help you reach your peak performance level. You can't expect to evolve and reach new heights if you only stick to your normal habits and routine lifestyle.
- Build Resilience: Life is unpredictable and it's important to have the skills and confidence to face them head on. Knowing that you were able to overcome something you thought was insurmountable will build your confidence and reinforce your independence.
- Being involved with music, drama and dance builds strong relationships between pupils and their teachers, and this reinforces their identity within the school
- Not letting the team down: Many hours of preparation go into writing, preparing, rehearsing and organising a production. Students have been practising for weeks for this event. Non attendance means that we need to rework choreography. This can confuse students and takes additional time.

My best memories about school were productions and camps. Whilst there were times I really didn't want to attend (E.g. kayaking camp) once I had, I felt a sense of achievement and was glad that mum and dad made me do it!

Assistant Principal's Report

This week, as part of the PMSS professional learning that Sharon mentioned above, I attended a session by Dr James Russo. He demonstrated how powerful images such as videos, photos, drawings and film can be used in the teaching of maths concepts to children. James is a lecturer in maths, science and technology and has undertaken a number of research projects in these areas. I also heard from Charles Lovitt. Charles is a maths consultant, both in Australia and internationally. He has a wealth of knowledge in maths and provides challenging, engaging and fun maths activities that develop children's maths understanding.

My take away from the session is that Charles always came back to what was the impact of the activity and the purpose of the lesson. He spoke about real life activities and the story behind an activity, what is the context for the activity? His activities engage reluctant learners and gave teachers ways to present the lesson in a non threatening way. Can you solve the following activity:

Four Piles Problem: Challenge 1

To place 20 blocks into 4 piles such that: The first pile has three more than the third pile The third pile has one more than pile 2 Pile 4 has twice as many as pile 2

Have a go with your family. The answer will be provided next week.










MWHPS School Production News





All these elements of performing arts give children the tools they need to build confidence, improve concentration, and an increased awareness of what they can achieve.




