During the first week of Term Four, an order form will be sent home for families to purchase a USB of the photos taken on the night of the production. USB's will cost \$15.


LEAVING OUR SCHOOL

- Develop logical thinking and problem-solving skills
- Express ideas & boost confidence working in a collaborative environment
- Enable the grasp of computational thinking which combines math and logic
