Our last Curriculum Day for this year will be held on Monday 4 November. Students will not attend on this day.


INQUIRY SHOWCASE - 7-8.15pm

Curriculum Update

This term the Year 5/6 students will be participating in a SEA 'Living and Growing' program (Sex Education Australia). The programs are age-appropriate, and cover not just anatomy, puberty and reproduction but also body safety (protective behaviours), respect, friendships and the risks of technology. The course is devised in line with the Victorian Curriculum, and are run with sensitivity, patience and humour. 
EXTEND UPDATE

What's Been Happening?




