Principal's Report

GOOGLE REFERENCE SCHOOL

Mount Waverley Heights Primary School has been recognised by Google for their outstanding use of technology to drive positive learning outcomes. As such, the school has been awarded Global Reference School status by Google, the first government primary school in Victoria to achieve this level of proficiency. The school is now visited by educators from across the world as a "best in world" example of the learning outcomes that are possible when technology is used to deliver 21st Century learning skills.

This is part of an ongoing partnership with Google, Hewlett-Packard Australia, and Datacom.

On Monday 9th December, the Industry partners will come together at a special assembly at the school to present this prestigious achievement to the school community.


SRC - New Fruit Juice Icy Poles!
