ONLINE LEARNING

During Term 2, students will access their learning from either the Learning Hub (can also be found on the home screen of our website) for Years P - 2 or Google Classroom for Years 3 - 6. Students will be able to access learning tasks via the above platforms. We understand that parents aren't teachers and undertaking learning tasks can be a challenge. Teachers will provide relevant work, however this is not in the capacity of a normal school day (eg. it is not an expectation that teachers will post 5 hours of work per day or that the tasks are the same as if students were at school).

The following are the daily minimum guidelines schools are expected to provide as set by the Department of Education & Training (DET):

Prep to Grade 2, schools will provide learning programs that include the following:

- 45-60 min of literacy activities
- 30-45 min of numeracy activities
- 30-45 min of additional learning areas, play-based learning and physical activity

Grades 3 to 6, schools will provide learning programs allocated as follows:

- 45-60 min of literacy activities
- 30-45 min of numeracy activities
- 30 min Physical activities
- 90 min of additional curriculum areas

In addition to the activities provided online, we will also be utilising video conferencing sessions where students will be able to meet with their classroom teacher and their peers in real time. We will be using Google Meet as our platform. All learning can be accessed from a tablet, ipad, phone, laptop or chromebook. Please take time to read the handout we sent via Sentral and email that outlines exactly when and how to get online.

Online Video Conferencing Sessions: Please note that P-2 parents will be sent an email. Years 3-6 will find the link at the top of their google classroom.





