### INQUIRY PROJECTS YEARS 3-6

MWHPS use a modified version of the Global Goals. These goals were developed by world leaders and were devised to create a better world by 2030, by ending poverty, fighting inequality and addressing the urgency of climate change.



Through our big inquiry challenge, students are encouraged to create solutions for global issues, to find their passion and to take action. We want students to believe in themselves and realise that they can make a difference. Students are given genuine choices about what they will learn, how they will inquire and how they will show their learning journey.

Students not only develop an awareness of an issue but the choice to pursue their learning pathway and to create, devise, assist or solve an issue that they are passionate about to improve their world, country, community, family or school.

Students will spend 6 months pursuing their topic and present their findings at our Inquiry Showcase.

Students will be introduced to the topics tomorrow and submit their preferences on Monday. This year the topics cover..

- Eradicating poverty
- Affordable and clean energy
- Reducing Inequalities
- Climate action
- Life below water

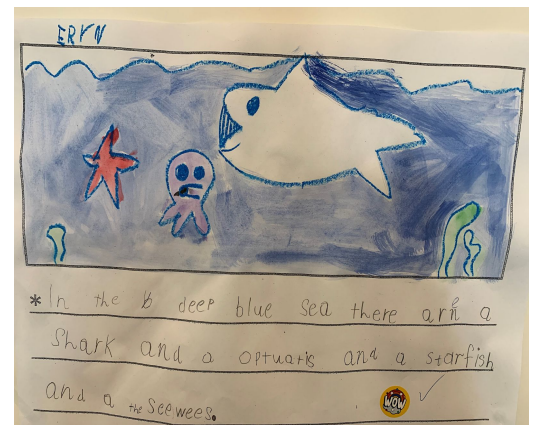
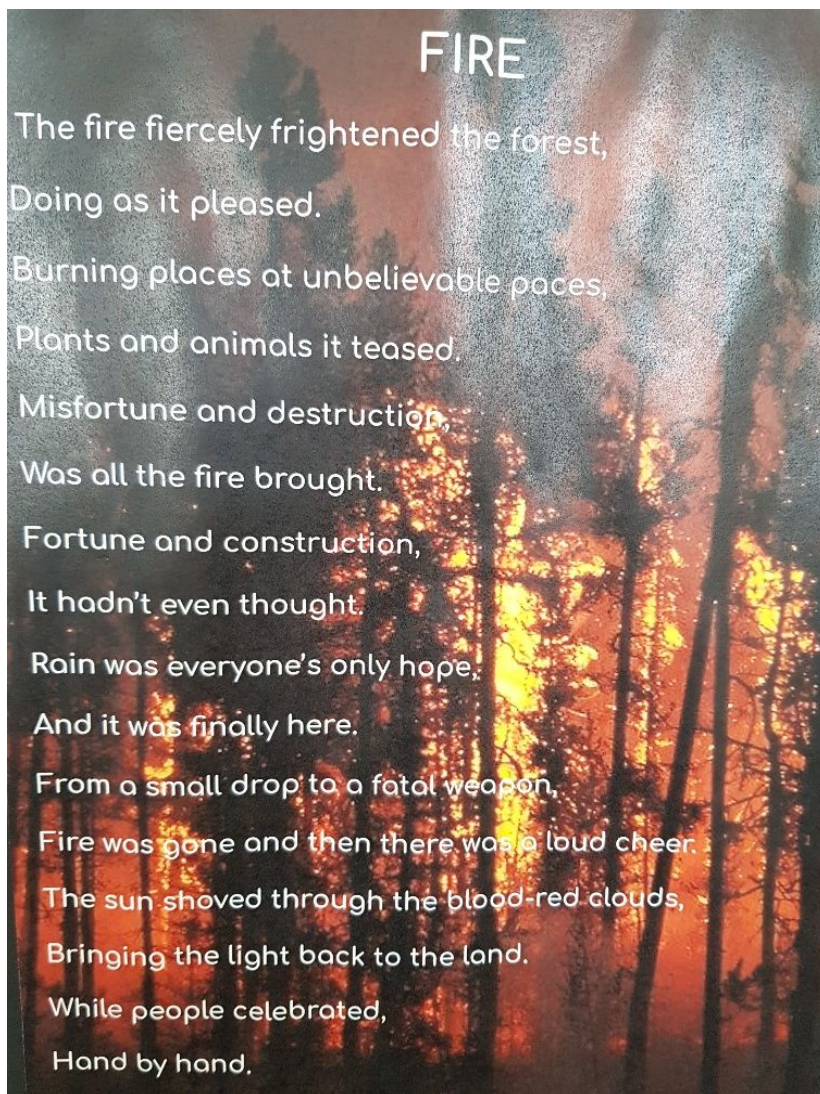
### 2020 SCHOOL LEVY PAYMENT PLANS

Families that had entered payment plans for this year's school fees, these will resume July 16th (Week One of Term 3). Any queries please see Louise or Sharon at the school office.

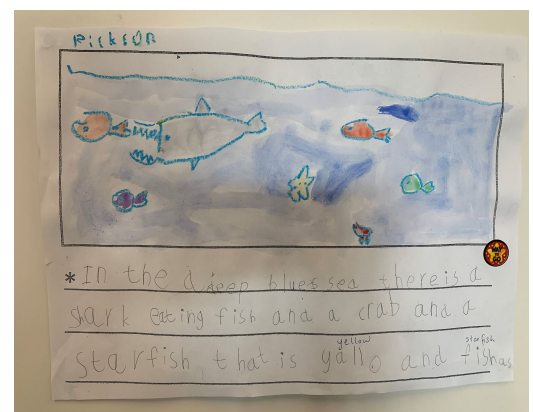


## CLASSROOM VISITS

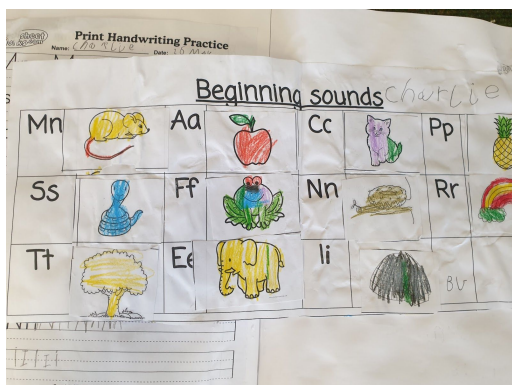


# Assistant Principal's Report

## Curriculum Update

I have been visiting our classrooms each morning and it has been wonderful to see the students so settled and engaged in their learning.

The Preps have been working on cued articulation, sounds and letters. In Prep J, students played the Monster Sound game where they had to identify a three letter word and their sounds. As part of our REACH framework (R: revisit, E: explicit teaching, A: apply and assess, C: challenge, H: how will they reflect on their learning), students are always given an opportunity for Challenge. In Monster Sounds, Mrs Johnson stretched the words to four letters which allowed the students to challenge themselves with longer words.
