WE ARE BACK!

Not the way we had all hoped - but we have a fantastic learning program organised for our students! As a result of your feedback, we have increased the number of video conferencing sessions. This will now mean that we have more small group sessions alongside whole class meets. This approach will target and better support the learning needs of all our students.

You will also notice optional online specialist lessons. Our specialist teams will meet with different levels to conduct a mini lesson online. Please note that these sessions will probably be between 20-30mins in length. Specialists will be teaching concepts and discussing tasks which are posted online. It provides an opportunity for students to ask questions, be provided with instructions on how to complete the task and discuss expectations. Students will then go off to complete their lesson. That is the same for all specialists except for PE. Students will have the opportunity to be active with Mrs Black!

You will notice a different looking 'Learning Hub'. This takes into account the small group learning sessions and will hopefully enable you to manage your child's learning more effectively. There won't be as many tasks posted, as students will be required to meet more frequently with their teacher for lessons online.

Remember to do what you can. Literacy and Numeracy are the most important tasks to complete. If you are struggling, let your child's teacher know and they can assist you in reducing the amount of tasks. The tasks we ask you to upload to SeeSaw are important, as these will be assessed by your child's class teacher.

REQUESTS FOR ONSITE ATTENDANCE

Each Monday a form will be sent out via email for any new families requiring their child to attend school onsite. Please remember that both parents must leave the house for work to be eligible.

Please note that you only need to fill in this form once. This needs to be submitted by 12pm every Wednesday. THIS IS FOR NEW FAMILY APPLICATIONS ONLY. If your roster changes, please email through the details. The school will email you by Wednesday afternoon confirming your child's attendance for the following week. It is crucial that you follow these timelines as we use this data to ensure that we have enough staff in attendance.

Your child must not attend school if they show any signs of illness.

FACEMASKS

Please note that as of today facemasks must be worn by parents on school premises. Teachers are required to wear them when walking between buildings and during staff meetings or gatherings.

CAMPS & EXCURSIONS

Unfortunately, we have had to cancel our Year 3/4 camp for 2020. The camp was unable to provide an alternate date. With so many unknowns, it has become almost impossible to look for another venue. Sentral App



- Access your newsfeeds instantly


Access reports using your Sentral app: Click the portal tile - It takes you to your Parent Portal Home Feed

If you are still having any issues, try finding the answers in the guides, uninstall and reinstall the app and/or try changing your password. If you are still having a problem please email the school office.


