Here are a few tips for saving money on power, And tips for your garden.

Sustainable tip: Unplug and turn off power points when you are not using them to save electricity. Some people call this “Phantom load”. It can cost you \$100 more each year so by unplugging and switching off your power points you can save a lot.

Gardening tip: Tomatoes, cucumbers, peppers, peas, beans, corn and squash grow well in full sunlight. Carrots, radishes and beets need at least half a day of sun to grow well. Leafy greens like spinach and many types of lettuce can grow with more shade.

ONLINE ORDERING Your child's school photos are now available for secure online purchase, please note if you are ordering online, you do not need to return an envelope to the school
