- Assemblies can be attended by staff only


















ONLINE SURVEY- SHORT TERM REMOTE LEARNING FEEDBACK

Thank you to the 140 parents who responded to the survey. Here is a summary of the results.


How have you found the amount of work assigned to your child?

140 responses




How have you found the difficulty level of work assigned?

140 responses










Do you find the sessions to be




Too short Just the right amount of time

In terms of the amount of sessions



As you can see, the results have been overwhelmingly positive. From the personal comments received we have learned that families would prefer greater space between online sessions to complete tasks (however, families also enjoyed having the afternoons free from learning tasks) and that it is difficult to organise children to join the online lessons, when both parents are working. We can sympathise with the last comment as teachers also experienced difficulty juggling the learning of their own children, whilst meeting MWHPS demands! Very tricky! This feedback has been invaluable. If we need to move to online learning once again, we know we have an approach that suits most people. Thank you again for your feedback.

ONLINE INTERVIEWS

6. Click 'save'.



Just to clarify, you are unable to physically read the books on the challenge website. Students will need to find books to read at home and borrow them from the library. To complete the challenge, students in Prep to Year 2 need to read or experience 30 books, including at least 20 books that are classified as Challenge books. Students from Year 3 to Year 6 need to read 15 books, including at least 10 Challenge books.


