### LEARNING UPDATE FOR PARENTS

#### WHAT'S CHANGED?

#### SEESAW CLASS (Prep and Year 1 families only)

We have reinstated Seesaw CLASS Home Learning Codes for the Prep and Grade 1 students. This will allow parents to return their child's work to their child's teacher via the Seesaw CLASS app. This worked extremely well during remote learning in 2020 and their posts are added directly to their personal Seesaw learning journal. Each child's home learning code will be distributed via your Seesaw FAMILY inbox over the next 48 hours with detailed instructions on how to download the free CLASS app if you don't already have it, and how to enter your child's code.

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## GOOGLE CLASSROOM (Year 2 only)

Year 2s will be working in Google Classroom in conjunction with the Learning Hub from next Monday 7th June. The instructions for each day will continue to be posted on the Learning Hub and the children will be directed to their Google Classrooms to access their learning tasks. This will allow our students to interact with their learning tasks and reduce the need for printing. Their teachers will be able to see their work and provide feedback in real time. The children can return their work for marking within the classroom and can ask questions using the private comment function. We will be posting step by step instructions and a video tutorial for parents on how to access Google Classroom on the Learning Hub. Mr DeMarchi and Miss Jamieson will be taking the children through how to log in during their Google Meets on Friday morning.

## WEDNESDAY (JUNE 9th)

  - We will get through this together

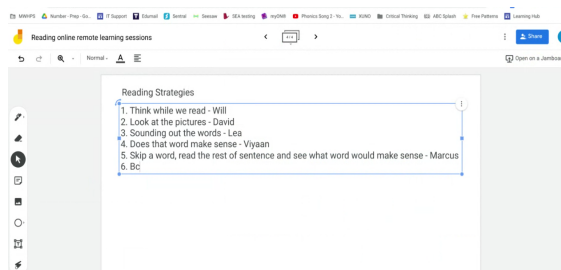
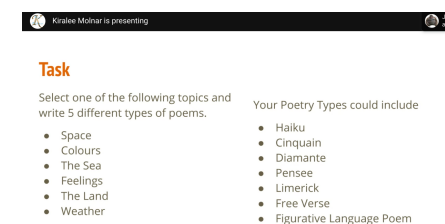
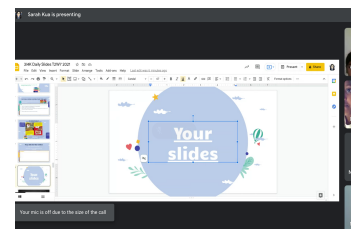
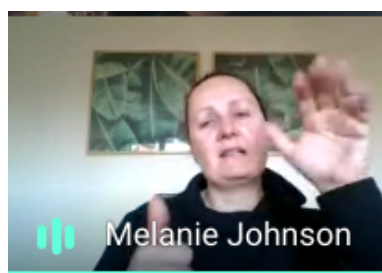
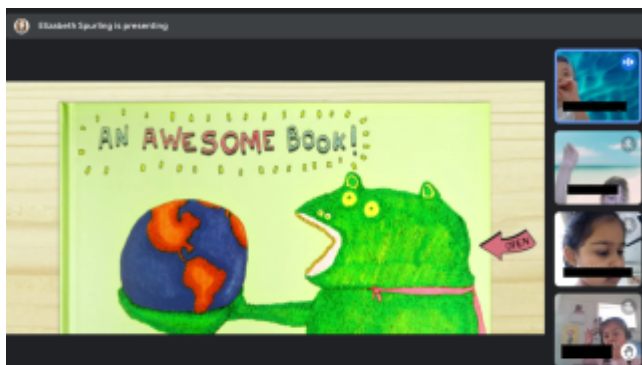
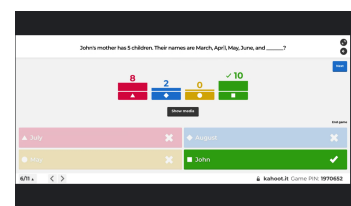
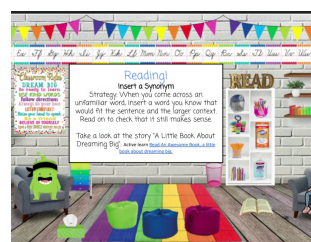
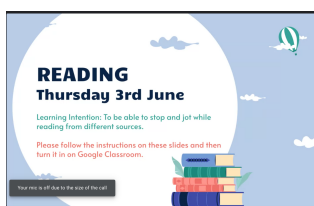
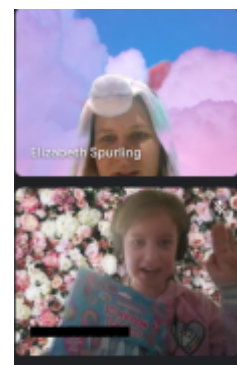

# Assistant Principal's Report

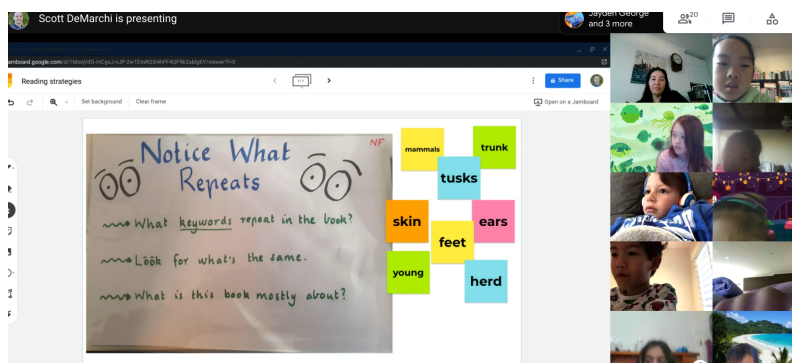
## Remote Learning @ MWHPS

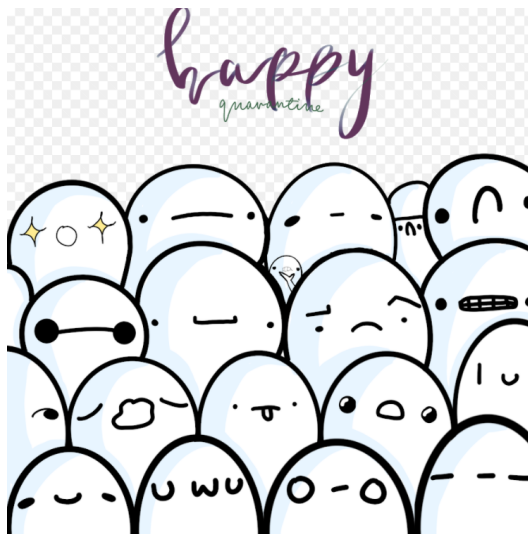
## Iso Art!

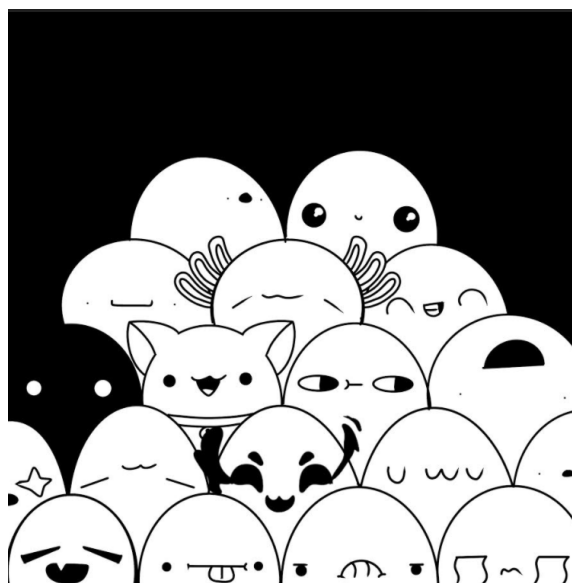

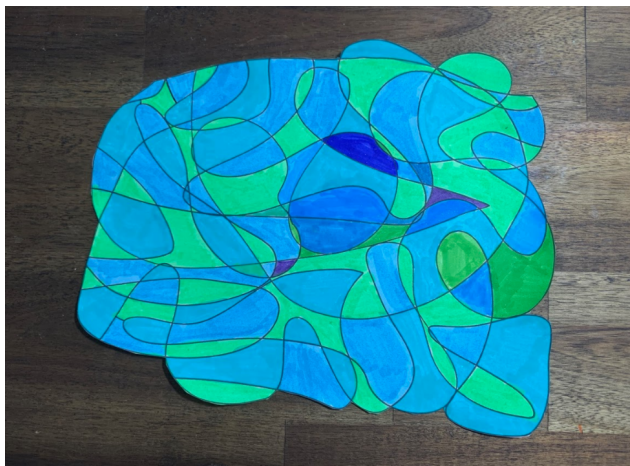
