Australian Early Development Census

A letter has gone home to families today. There is nothing for families or students to do, the teachers complete the census during school time. If you would like to opt out of this census please let Julie at the office know by Wednesday 20 July or Sentral message your class teacher.

Once our prep teachers finish collecting information for the 2021 Australian Early Development Census, the data is analysed and prepared for publication in March 2022.

The census results are presented as groups of children at local, state and national levels. This ensures children and schools remain anonymous.




ICAS Reminder
