PARENT - TEACHER CHAT

On Tuesday February 22 we will be offering parents an opportunity to meet with their child's classroom teacher to share vital information about their child's learning requirements and provide parents with an opportunity to discuss any concerns regarding their child's academic, social and emotional development. In some cases a parent sharing relevant background information such as a child's academic strengths, their social and emotional competencies, their family circumstances or medical/health information, can be invaluable to a teacher catering for a child in their care. Information regarding the exchange night was distributed last week. Parents can book a 10min chat with teachers through Sentral.

Meetings are only 10mins long. Please don't be offended if the teacher begins to wrap up the chat. As you can imagine, times blow out really easily if we don't keep to schedule. If there is anything that needs to be discussed in more detail, a further meeting can be arranged.

Please note that parents need to be double vaccinated to attend this meeting in person.

EXCURSION/INCURSION PAYMENTS and APPROVALS ON SENTRAL










RECYCLE YOUR OLD PENS AND MARKERS WITH US!
