WHOLE SCHOOL PRODUCTION TONIGHT

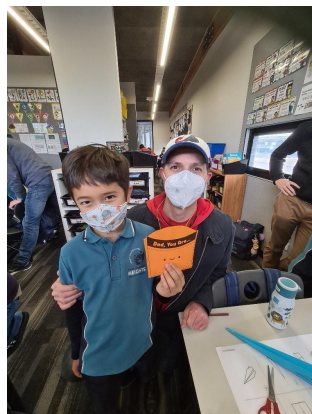
Tonight's the Night! The students have been buzzing all week! The excitement is definitely in the air!

Assistant Principal's Report

WELLBEING

This week Mr Morris, Mrs Geddes and I participated in a professional learning day for SWPBS (School Wide Positive Behaviour Support) - Classroom Systems. Implementation of SWPBS requires commitment by the whole school community and you would be aware of our school expectations - Be respectful, Be Responsible and Be Inclusive.

SWPBS uses a tiered intervention framework which invests in:

- primary prevention (tier 1): supports for all students, staff and settings
- secondary prevention (tier 2): additional specialised group systems for students with at-risk behaviour
- tertiary prevention (tier 3): specialised, individualised systems for students with high-risk behaviour, provided in addition to primary and secondary prevention.

Classroom Systems looks at the eight effective teaching and learning practices that make up classroom systems, it assists with analysing data to implement with fidelity and it identifies strategies for deeper implementation and ongoing monitoring. From next term the Wellbeing team will start to look at implementing Classroom Systems across the school.

Mrs Geddes and I also met with our SWPBS coach to complete a Tiered Fidelity Inventory for our school. It is to basically monitor and see where we are up to with implementation of SWPBS.

I want to congratulate our students, staff and parents because our school scored **93%**.

What a remarkable result, it means that we have great processes and practices embedded into everything we do.

- Prep students need to be signed in with their teacher in the training room at Crossway, which is located in the upstairs theatre foyer.
- Students in Years 1 - 6 will need to be dropped off at the entry in the bottom car park to the right of the playground. Students will also be collected from here at the conclusion of the production.
- Prep, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 students are to come to the theatre dressed in their BLACK COSTUME
- Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 students are to come to the theatre dressed in their Revolting Children Costume (MWHPS uniform)
- All students will require a quiet, non electronic activity, water bottle and small NUT FREE snack for when they are not on the stage to keep them occupied.
- At the end of the performance students will be collected from the following points-
 - Prep - Training room in the upstairs foyer where they were dropped off
 - Year 1 - Year 6 - From the door at the bottom car park where they were dropped off.

All students must be collected from a staff member on the night. Students will not be able to leave if a parent is not seen by a staff member.

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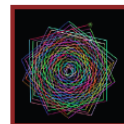

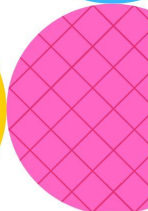
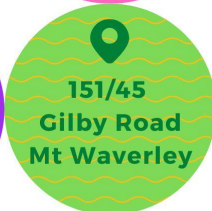
