## MEET YOUR 2023 TEACHER

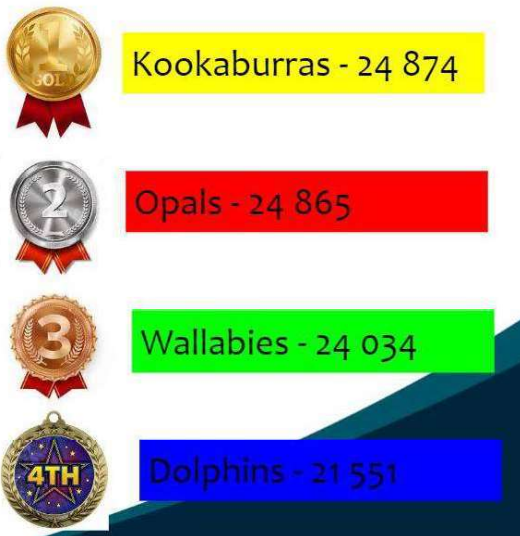
