We would also recommend that you are vigilant in what your child is viewing on tv and social media over the coming weeks. It can be quite challenging for primary age children to see and understand the horrors depicted.

OCTOBER IS CYBER SECURITY MONTH

The theme for 2023, 'Be cyber wise – don't compromise', encourages you to take 4 simple steps to be more cyber wise:

- 1. update your devices regularly
- 2. turn-on multi-factor authentication
- 3. backup your important files
- 4. use passphrases and password managers

Updating devices;

Updates are one of the strongest defences in your security toolkit. Updating your device and applications can fix issues and address new security concerns. Updates can also add new features to your app or device.

Updates are new, improved, or fixed versions of software. Regular updates are critical in maintaining a secure system. It's important to check for any updates and make sure that automatic updates are switched on. Cyber criminals hack devices by using known weaknesses in systems or apps. Updates have security upgrades to fix these weaknesses. You can turn on automatic updates so that this happens without your input.






DIVISION ATHLETICS




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Christmas Card Competition

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
