EVERYDAY COUNTS


Attending school every day means experiencing what counts – the learning, friendship, fun and opportunities that can shape your child’s future.

We have noticed an increase in the number of students arriving late to school. You might think that arriving 5–15 minutes late doesn’t matter, but those minutes add up. Coming in late means students miss crucial learning time, disrupt the flow of the lesson, and are not set up for a calm, successful start to their day.

There is a strong correlation between regular attendance and student success. When students miss more than 20 days in a year (10 days per semester), schools are required to meet with families to discuss concerns and provide support.

We understand that there are times when your child will need to miss school, but to ensure minimal disruption to their education, please consider scheduling family holidays or medical/dental appointments outside of school time. If your child is well enough to attend but is worried about friendships or schoolwork, please encourage them to come to school. Avoiding school can make these feelings worse and can create a negative pattern of behaviour.

Please see the image below: We know that low attendance impacts life chances. It is good to get into great habits now, while your child is in primary school.



If your child is having difficulty attending school, talk to their teacher, Mrs Datson or Mrs Deylen about getting support.

We know that parents and carers can be juggling challenges daily to get your children to school. If your child must miss school, notify us as soon as possible via Compass so we can work together to support them.

MULTICULTURAL DAY

Are there any parents who would like to run an activity on the day? Last year we had our Korean families showcase their traditional games and cultural attire. We also had a Sri Lankan dad who introduced the Year 5s to traditional masks. In the past, we had our Indian families run dancing and henna art activities. I'm a multilingual counsellor and passionate about supporting children's wellbeing in a safe, respectful, and developmentally appropriate way. I use evidence-informed approaches and work closely with families and staff to help students feel supported at school. I work at MWHPS on Thursdays. Outside of work I enjoy Paddleboarding, Yoga and Bollywood movies.

MY EXPERIENCE

I have a Bachelors in Arts (Psychology major), Masters in Counselling and a certificate in Play Therapy. I've worked with children and families in education and community settings. You might've seen me around as I did my placements with MWHPS over the last year and half.

MY ROLE IN SCHOOL

I support students' wellbeing at school. Counselling is a safe, calm space where children can talk, draw, play and learn helpful skills. I support with worries and big feelings, friendships, confidence, coping with change(home/school) and emotion regulation. I use a trauma-informed, strengths-based approach and adapt sessions to each child's age and needs.

In partnership with the school, I provide short-term, goal-focused counselling support for students, consult with teachers to support classroom and wellbeing needs, liaise with families where appropriate, support referrals to external services when needed, and contribute to whole-school wellbeing initiatives as required.
