CURRICULUM DAY

One of my favourite things to do is spend time on curriculum and as you can imagine in my role, sometimes other things take priority. However, curriculum is my passion. I am always super keen to continue my learning journey. This year I have been completing an online course with the Department of Education on the Science of Learning - How teaching and learning happens. It has been really confirming that our Instructional Model aligns with these principles. This course has come at a great time - a time where we were refining our practice.

On Friday, teachers had the opportunity to build upon our Instructional Approach and connect it to key understandings from the Science of Learning research. The tech, literacy and wellbeing teams were also able to offer a range of sessions in the afternoon, providing staff with opportunities to explore specific areas of practice and further build their knowledge and skills.

Thank you to all the leaders involved in planning and facilitating the sessions. Your knowledge, preparation and enthusiasm helped make the day a valuable and engaging professional learning experience for everyone.

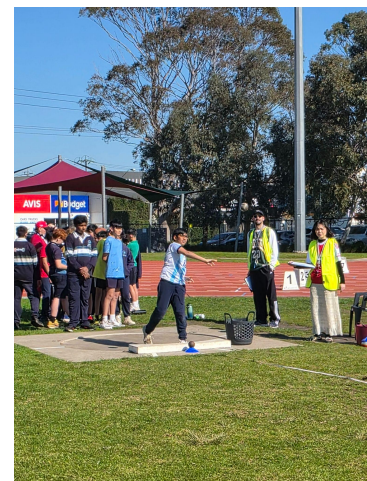
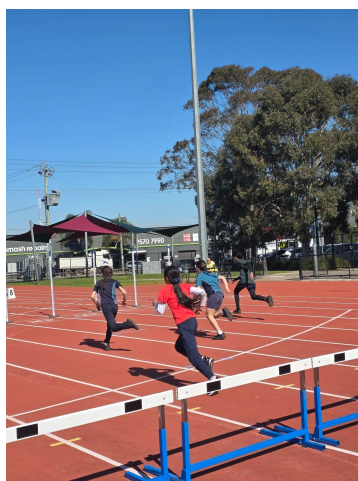
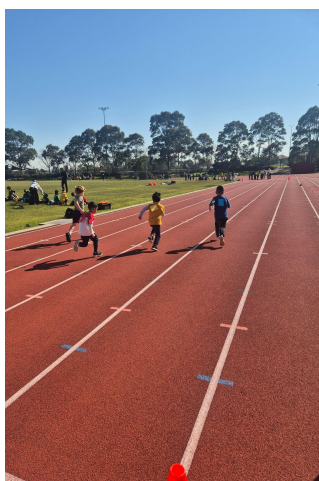

Family Activity

MINDFUL MOVEMENT: CONNECTING BODY & MIND

As a family, discuss how often when we move, we do so mindlessly. We are more focused on where we are trying to get to or the thoughts spinning around in our heads. **When we move with mindfulness, it becomes a fantastic way to bring together movement of the body and focus of the mind.**

ACTIVITY IDEA: FAMILY WALKING MEDITATION

Set aside time to take a short walk together. As you walk, practice mindful movement by focusing on each step you take. **Remind yourselves that your body is moving, while your mind remains calm and present.**

Here are some ideas to help you focus:

- ★ Pay attention to **your breath** as you walk.
- ★ Notice how your **arms swing**, your **feet lift**, and your **knees bend**.
- ★ **Focus on the sensation** of your foot touching the ground: heel, ball, and toes.

After your walk, talk about how it felt. Did it help you feel more centered? Where else in your daily life could mindful movement be helpful?
