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ILLNESS

A few bugs are going around! There has certainly been a lot of illness making its way around the school recently, and it is having an impact on both students and staff. We appreciate that this can be challenging for families, particularly when children are unwell and routines are disrupted. A reminder that if your child is feeling unwell, please keep them at home until they have recovered. This not only helps your child get the rest they need, but also helps prevent illness from spreading to others. On Wednesday we had 8 staff members absent! We are also now receiving notifications from (Casual Relief Teacher) agencies that there are no teachers available! We are doing our best to keep things running as normal as possible, but with staff and students both being affected, your support in helping us minimise the spread is greatly appreciated.

SWIMMING PROGRAM

Our swimming program for Preps, 3s and 5s will commence in Term 4. Our swimming program is about so much more than learning how to swim. Being confident and safe around water is an essential life skill, particularly in Australia where children are often around pools, beaches and waterways. Swimming lessons help students develop water safety awareness, learn what to do in an emergency and build the skills and confidence to keep themselves safe. They also provide an opportunity to develop fitness, coordination, strength and perseverance. For some students, getting into the water can be challenging, so the program also helps build resilience and confidence as they work towards mastering new skills.

On the first day at the pool, students will be assessed on their swimming skills and then placed in groups. These groups range from students who are unable to swim to those that take swimming lessons and are very confident in the water. We are encouraging all students to attend.

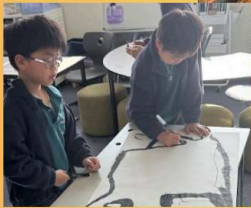

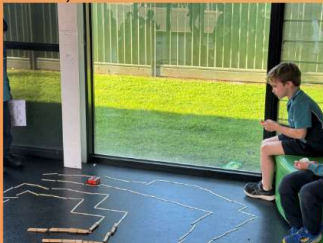
ROBOT NAMES
